DAY USE PERMIT-\$10.00 per day per person

- Purchase permit on site at self-pay stations or online at https://fisheries.warmsprings-nsn.gov/tribal-fishing-permits/
- The Permit is to be kept with you and must be presented to an enforcement officer when requested.
- This permit does not allow overnight camping.
- Day use vehicles must vacate the site by 10 p.m.

ANNUAL DAY USE PERMIT - \$50.00 per person January-June; \$50.00 per person, July-December

- The following information is needed:
 - -Name and address of permit holder
 - -Telephone number
- Each person needs to sign their cards upon receiving in mail.
- This permit is to be kept with you and presented to an enforcement officer when requested.
- This permit is for day use only; it does not allow overnight camping.
- Day use vehicles must vacate the site by 10 p.m.
- Children 14 years and older must have a permit.

CAMPING PERMITS - \$10.00 per night

- Purchase permit on site at self-pay station or online at https://fisheries.warmsprings-nsn.gov/tribal-fishing-permits/
- The camping permit covers the day use for immediate family with children under 14.
- Camping will be restricted to one vehicle per camp space.
- Vacating time for campsites is 2:30p.m.
- No person shall camp at the Sherars Falls site for more than 14 consecutive nights.

OTHER REGULATIONS

- Pets must be kept on a leash no longer than 6 ft. in length or kept in a vehicle.
- Pets will be kept under control at all times.
- Owners of pets are responsible for the animal's behavior and for containment and removal of the animal's waste.
- Open fires and charcoal will be **PROHIBITED** from June 1 through October 15. This closure may begin early and possibly be extended if conditions warrant.
- When not prohibited, fire shall be contained in a fire pan or similar device of metal.
- Burning of any living, dead or down vegetation within the Sherars Falls site shall be prohibited.
